

New Zealand Transport Agency (Speed Limits on State Highways) Amendment Bylaw 2011/4

Pursuant to section 61(3) of the Government Roading Powers Act 1989, and the Land Transport Rule: Setting of Speed Limits 2003, the NZ Transport Agency hereby makes the following bylaw.

Bylaw

1. Title and commencement–

This bylaw may be cited as the New Zealand Transport Agency (Speed Limits on State Highways) Amendment Bylaw 2011/4 and will come into force 28 days after the date of publication of this notice in the New Zealand Gazette.

2. Amendment–

The New Zealand Transport Agency (Speed Limits on State Highways) Bylaw 2010/10* is hereby amended by:

– Amending line 735 in Schedule 1 to read:

"Line No.: 735

Region: 9

SH No.: 2

Locality: Lower Hutt

Section of State Highway: SOUTHBOUND – from the northern, central pier of the McKenzie Avenue Overbridge to 270m south of the southern face of the central pier of the Petone Overbridge.

Speed Limit (km/h): 80

– Inserting line 735A in Schedule 1 to read:

"Line No.: 735A

Region: 9

SH No.: 2

Locality: Lower Hutt

Section of State Highway: NORTHBOUND – from 270m south of the southern face of the central pier of the Petone Overbridge to the southern, central pier of the McKenzie Avenue Overbridge.

Speed Limit (km/h): 80
