## Recognising a frontal impact compliant Porsche vehicle

To determine frontal impact compliance for Class MA Porsche models, examine the Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) following the instructions outlined in the box below.

Class MA Porsche models that are manufactured in right-hand drive form will comply with an approved frontal impact standard if they have a VIN that:

- Starts with the letters WPO

AND

- Has a 10<sup>th</sup> character that is a G, H, J, K, L, M, N, P, R, S, T, V, W, X, Y, 1 or 2\*

For example, a vehicle with a VIN of **WPO** ##### **G**# ##### would be frontal impact compliant.

\*Note: The 10<sup>th</sup> character denotes the model year, as follows:
