I want to stay safe

My booster comes with me until I'm 148cm tall.



It is the law that:

- all children under seven must be secured in an approved child restraint appropriate for their age and size
- children aged seven must be secured in an approved child restraint if one is available in the vehicle, and if not, in any child restraint or safety belt that is available.

Best practice recommends that children stay in a restraint or booster seat until they're 148cm tall

Retailers and other organisations may have certified child restraint technicians who can provide you with advice and assistance. Certified child restraint technicians are trained to NZ Qualifications Authority unit standards.
