Objective of the Rule

The objective of Land Transport Rule: Traffic Control Devices (Kura/School Signs) Amendment 2022 (this Rule) is to make amendments to Land Transport Rule: Traffic Control Devices 2004, including to:

- replace existing school signs with kura school signs; and
- create new kura school signs; and
- prescribe formatting requirements for kura school signs; and
- provide for the particular circumstances under which kura school signs are to be used; and
- remove signs referring to 'school zone'.

Extent of consultation

Waka Kotahi NZ Transport Agency (Waka Kotahi) sent out notifications of the proposed amendments by email to approximately 42 groups and individuals who had registered an interest in the rule to be amended (the *Land Transport Rule: Traffic Control Devices 2004*).

The consultation draft rule (titled *Land Transport Rule: Traffic Control Devices* (*Kura/School Signs*) Amendment 2021) was made available, together with an overview document, on Waka Kotahi's website. Public consultation was carried out from 4 November 2021 to 17 December 2021. The availability of the consultation draft rule for comment was publicised in the *Gazette* on 5 November 2021.

Waka Kotahi received approximately 564 submissions on the consultation draft rule. The submissions received were taken into account in finalising the *Land Transport Rule: Traffic Control Devices (Kura/School Signs) Amendment 2022*, following which it was submitted to the Minister of Transport for signing.
