NOTES TO SPECIFICATION FOR EMERGENCY WORK

(Storm damage, debris, slips)

1. **RESPONSE TIME**

TNZ Regional Managers may have different response times because of local circumstances and should nominate road group numbers or special conditions accordingly.

1.1 Protection of Road Users

Suggested wording:

The road and the adjacent area shall be made safe to all road users as soon as possible but no longer than 1 hour plus normal travelling time from depot to site from the time of receiving a request to undertake the work. This shall apply to all road groups.

1.2 Emergency Patrols

Suggested wording:

Emergency patrols shall be underway within 20 minutes from the time of receiving a request to inspect roads nominated by the Engineer. This shall apply to all road groups.

1.3 Repair work to re-establish access

Suggested response times to commence repair work are

Road Group	Response Times	
	Daylight	Darkness
1	2 hrs	2 hrs
2	2 hrs	4 hrs
3 and 4	4 hrs	6 hrs

2. PLANT AND LABOUR HIRE RATES

The Contactor will be required to submit rates and availability of plant and labour for various locations within the areas covered by specific contacts at time of tender.

The Engineer will be required to negotiate with the Contractor to reach agreement on the appropriate levels of plant and labour to cover foreseeable emergencies within specific geographical locations.

The rates and availability of the resources agreed to shall continue for the duration of each contract. The Contractor shall be required to assure the Engineer of his ability to comply with the resource availability including back up resources.
