Review and replacement of the *Manual of Traffic Signs and Markings* – Information

In 2005 a consultation document was published by Land Transport New Zealand (Land Transport NZ) seeking views on a project to review and replace *Manual of Traffic Signs and Markings* (MOTSAM).
