Request made under the Official Information Act 1982

Thank you for your email of 6 June 2024 requesting the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

1. *Your agency's digital (IT or ICT) strategy.*
2. *Your agency's technology strategy (if separate from your digital strategy).*
3. *Your agency's data or information strategy (if separate from your digital strategy).*
4. *A documented report that demonstrates progress on your digital/technology/data strategy implementation.*

The document *Auahatanga_Digital_Strategy_Aug_2023.pdf* falls within the scope of your first request and is enclosed.

In respect of requests 2, 3 and 4, I am refusing these under clause 18(e) of the Act which provides for refusal when documents do not exist. NZ Transport Agency Waka Kotahi (NZTA) does not have separate technology or data strategies and does not yet have a report which demonstrates progress towards our digital strategy.
