- It is the transport service licence holder identified in the windscreen of the permitted vehicle who has the responsibility to operate within the regulatory requirements relating to static roll threshold (SRT), brake code and other applicable vehicle ratings, as well as any other rules such as speed, road user charges (RUC) or log book hours.
- You must complete ALL fields otherwise we may be unable to process your application.
- Please attach more pages if there isn't enough space on this form.
- You might be eligible for an extended permit term if you are operating under a contract with a local authority.
- You can apply for multiple identical vehicles on a single application form. Attach a separate list of plate numbers if required. Each vehicle must carry a copy of its permit in a readable format that can be produced on demand for inspection by an enforcement officer, an authorised agent of NZ Transport Agency Waka Kotahi (NZTA) or a road controlling authority.
- If you are applying for multiple identical vehicles (which must all have the same load share ratio), you need to submit only one photograph of a compliance plate with your application.

The information will be disclosed to our agents and contractors and road controlling authorities in relation to these purposes. NZTA may use this information for the purposes of monitoring and regulating operator behaviour. NZTA may also disclose the information collected in this application to road controlling authorities for the purposes of network maintenance and operations.
