ROAD EFFICIENCY GROUP - TOOLS AND RESOURCES

The Road Efficiency Group Te Ringa Maimoa (REG) is a collaborative initiative between Local Government NZ, NZTA Waka Kotahi and all road controlling authorities. Our focus is building practical tools based on quality data and providing guidance to help roading asset managers do their job well. We have three work groups with members from across the sector who co-design solutions to improve asset management. Our regional champions help promote and support the programme around the country.

TRANSPORT INSIGHTS WEB PORTAL

Transport Insights helps RCAs, especially asset managers, better understand their network. It consolidates roading, financial and other statistical information from a range of sources and provides a number of trend analysis and comparative analysis, including utilising the One Network Framework for RCAs, regions and national reporting. In addition to the reporting functionality, Transport Insights drives data quality improvements by highlighting and reporting data issues. Transport Insights contains a number of embedded tools to facilitate the work of RCAs, such as the Traffic Estimation Tool.

DIFFERENTIAL LEVELS OF SERVICE

REG has compiled the infrastructure elements for setting Levels of Service into a Framework to ensure everyone in the sector is using the same language.

The Differential Levels of Service tool aims to provide a measure of national consistency while allowing flexibility for local affordability to be managed. The tool allows asset managers to try different scenarios to determine the effect on cost, outcomes and risk.

A key element of the project is consideration to differing service levels of different network classes as established using the One Network Framework.
