Safer speeds for your road

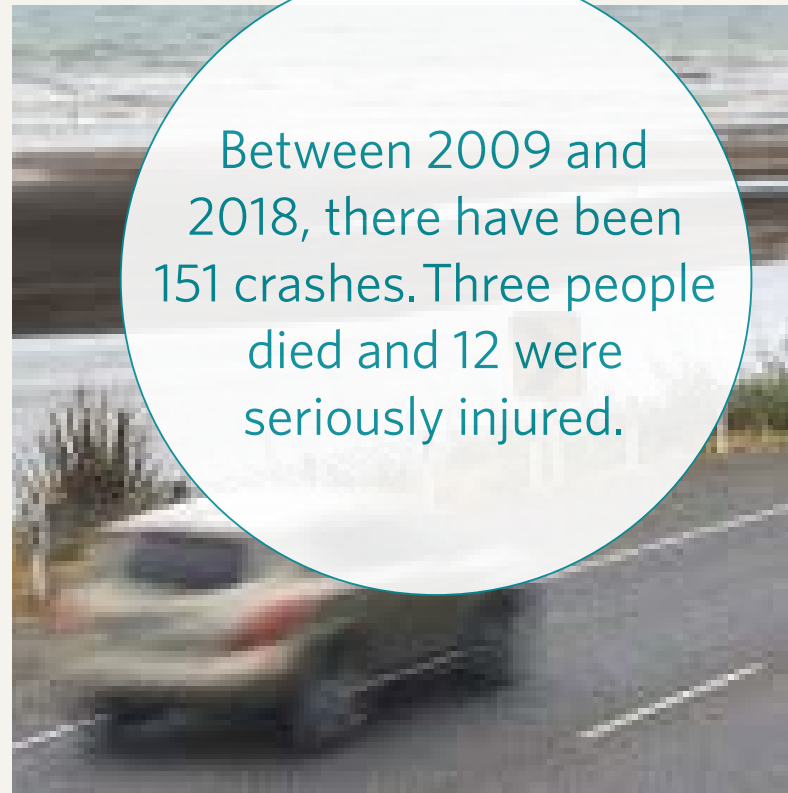
We want to make your roads safer for everyone who uses them. On some roads we're doing this with safety improvements like rumble strips, but on State Highway 10 (SH10), the best thing we can do to prevent people from dying or being seriously injured is reduce speed limits so they are safe and right for the road.

What we've heard

People in your community have told us that the speed limit on the stretch of road on SH10 between Awanui and Taipa feels too high to be safe.



Between 2009 and 2018, there have been 151 crashes. Three people died and 12 were seriously injured.

What we know

The village of Kareponia is especially risky due to children from the Kōhanga Reo crossing and school buses turning.

What we're proposing

Based on what we know, we think 80km/h would be a safer speed on SH10 between Awanui and Taipa.

Have your say

We want to know what you think.

After all, locals know their roads. We want to hear what you think about these proposed limits, as well as the current speed limits, and whether you believe some stretches are more dangerous than others.

We'll use your feedback to recommend what speed limits are best for these roads and then formally consult with you.

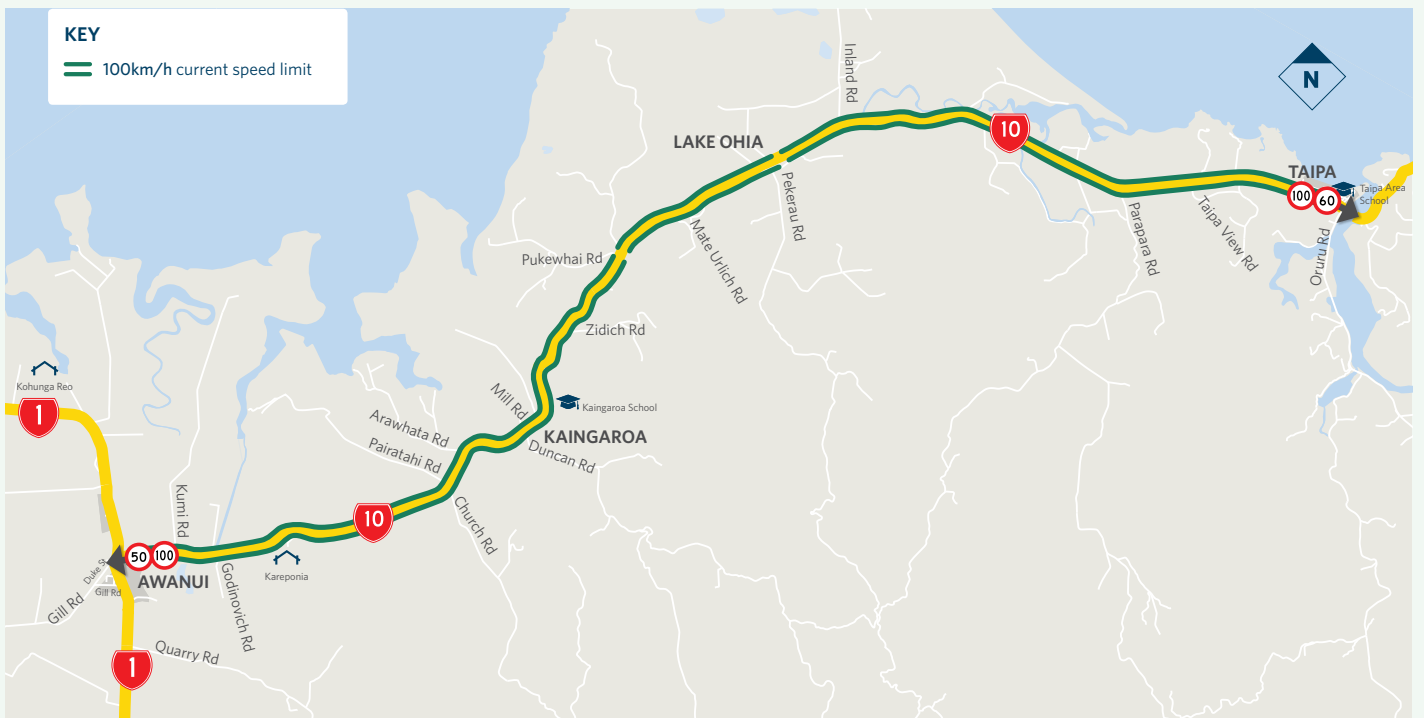

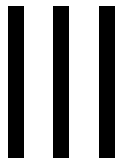


No matter what causes a crash, speed can be the difference between walking away or being carried away. Speed also reduces the time you have to react to a mistake, yours or someone else's.
