Land Transport Rule: Setting of Speed Limits 2022—Director approval to set speed limits

Thank you for your email dated 17 June 2024 requesting, in accordance with the Alternative Method process provided for under Clause 2.6 of the Land Transport Rule: Setting of Speed Limits 2022, Director of Land Transport approval for speed limit changes on:
