

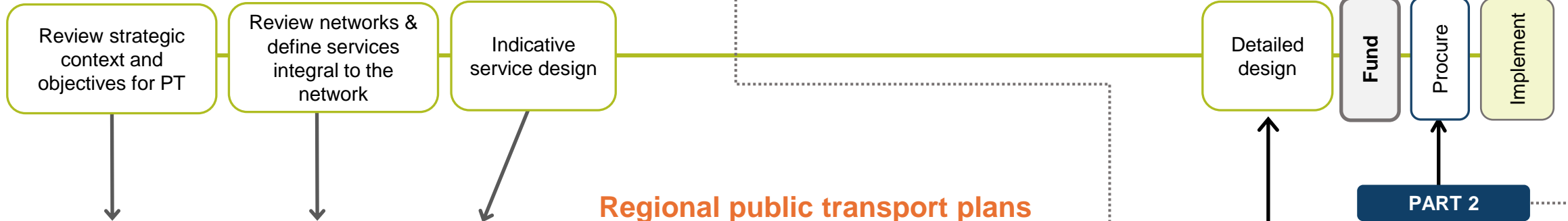
Planning and procurement dependencies

PTAs must gather, analyse and document information about their procurement programme and the environment in which they operate.

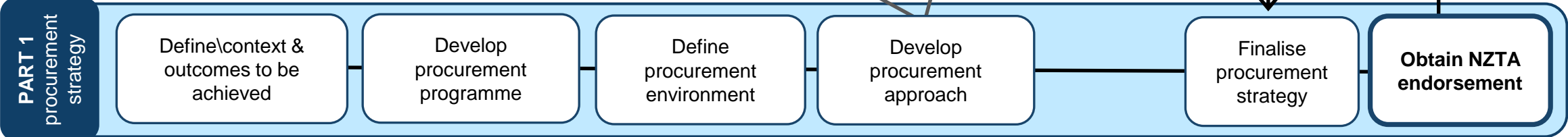
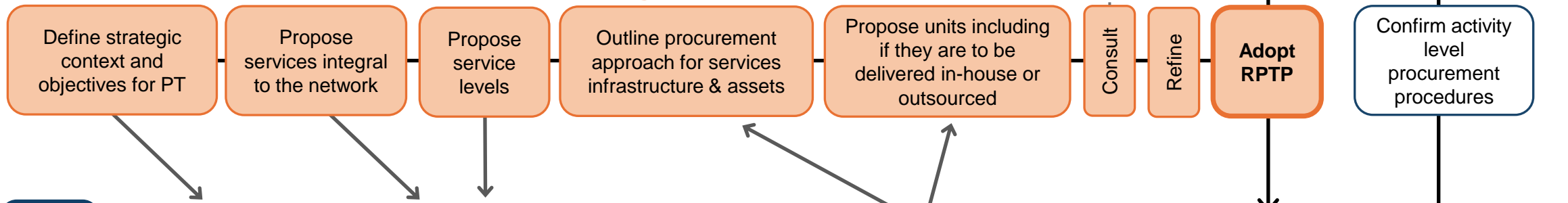
RPTPs must be publicly consulted. This provides an important transparency and engagement mechanism for the supplier market.

The higher-level decisions in a procurement strategy will inform a PTA's approach to procurement and provide context and direction when using Part 2 procurement procedures.

Include context for defining value for money.

Analyse resource inputs requirements such as energy, vehicles / vessels, enabling assets and labour over different time horizons

Analyse supplier market for resource inputs. Assess key risks & opportunities. Assess PTA capability and capacity.

Define asset control approach. Allocate services into units. Indicate delivery models, supplier select methods, and contracting elements for services, infrastructure and assets.
