

# 2024-27 National Land Transport Programme

## Factsheet

### Taranaki

- A total of \$808 million is forecast to be invested in Taranaki in the 2024-27 National Land Transport Programme (NLTP) period.
- Investment in Taranaki during the 2024-27 NLTP will create a safer and more efficient land transport system that supports economic growth and prosperity.
- The \$808 million forecast investment includes:
  - \$120m forecast maintenance operations investment
  - \$238m forecast to fix potholes investment
  - \$392m forecast improvements investment
  - \$22m forecast public transport investment
  - \$1.6m forecast safety investment
  - \$33m forecast walking and cycling investment

### Taranaki investment highlights for 2024-27

- Complete the sealing of the SH43 Forgotten World Highway
- Continue construction of the Mt Messenger Bypass Te Ara o Te Ata
- Continue safety improvements along SH3 Waitara to Bell Block
- Deliver safety improvements on SH3 between New Plymouth and Hāwera
- Reseal or rebuild 319 lane kilometres of state highway through targeted maintenance operations and fixing potholes.
- Replace the end-of-life SH3 Mangapepeki No.2 Culvert north of New Plymouth.
