
Business case 2024-27 overview

The Road Efficiency Group Te Ringa Maimoa (REG) is a collaborative partnership between NZ Transport Agency Waka Kotahi, Local Government NZ and all road controlling authorities across New Zealand.

REG's programmes are developed 'for the sector, by the sector', to address high variability across the national road network through helping RCAs become better procurers and providers of roads and services.

REG programme members are subject matter experts from across the sector who volunteer their time to build tools and guidance that enable trust, confidence and value in transport investment.



GPS 2024 response

GPS 2024 directed REG to refocus on ensuring that investment in maintaining and improving resilience on the state highway, local and rural road network is spent in the most efficient manner.

REG has updated its programme business case, refreshed its delivery model, appointed two independent governance members, and developed road controlling authorities' effectiveness benchmarking along with new quarterly/annual reporting.

Transport Insights web portal

Transport Insights brings together roading, financial and performance information from across the sector to provide a comprehensive view of the state of our road networks.

Performance measures and reporting

We are establishing performance measures for all road controlling authorities to benchmark activities and improve decision making.

Consistent condition data collection (CCDC)

CCDC establishes a consistent approach to collecting pavement and road surface condition data for all local authority sealed roads, including identifying how the data will be collected and managing the implementation across Aotearoa New Zealand.

Learning and Development Programme

Our Learning and Development Programme is designed to help transport asset managers tell a strong investment story. We deliver workshops throughout the country, supporting peer learning and giving guidance to improve decision-making.

Excellence Assessment

We use sector-developed standards to measure the performance of transport teams and road controlling authorities. The assessment gives teams a clear understanding of their performance across eight key areas, highlighting their strengths and opportunities for improvement.
