

# Bridges along the **Cambridge section**



- Length: 22m Width: 25m
- Carries Expressway traffic over Pickering Road

HEB and the NZ Transport Agency would like to thank the community for their patience throughout the project as traffic was transferred to the new alignment and speed restrictions were in place.



**Northern interchange** Te Koopuu Maania



- Length: 80.7m Width: 9.7m
- Provides a south-bound flyover for Expressway traffic to exit southbound, and a north-bound on-ramp for existing SH1 traffic to join the Expressway



# **Peake Road bridge** Te Ara o Te Waharoa

- Length: 43.6m Width: 13.6m
- Carries local traffic over the Expressway
- Wide shared path with higher railings for pedestrians and horse riders

# **Swayne Road bridge** Parawhau

- Length: 46.6m Width: 12.1m
- Carries local road traffic over the Expressway

# **Thornton Road bridge** Te Ara Noa

- Length: 38.2m Width: 12.8m
- Carries local traffic over the Expressway
- Is built at ground level with the Expressway approximately 6m below ground level at this point

# Te Oko Horoi

- Length: 54.9m Width: 11.0m
- Carries Expressway traffic over Victoria Road
- Provides a full diamond interchange with access on and off the Expressway both north and south-bound

- Length: 66.9m Width: 23m
- Delivers south-bound Expressway traffic back to the existing SH1 south of Cambridge
- Provides a north-bound off-ramp into Cambridge for SH1 traffic
