The new green and red arrows for turning traffic will be turned on when the centre traffic signal poles in the median islands are complete. We now expect this to happen overnight on **Sunday 24 May**.

The night work on **Sunday 17 May** involves a saw cutter to work on the signal loops. Nearby residents will hear the noise from the machines and the crew working at night, we will do the cutting as much as possible at the start of the shift.

The work on **Sunday night 24 May** involves a small crew working on commissioning the traffic signals and a crew raising two manhole covers within the intersection boundaries.
