PROJECT UPDATE 11 SEPTEMBER 2019



KERB AND CHANNEL WORK - NO ENTRY WESTON ROAD EASTBOUND

The Christchurch Northern Corridor (CNC)
Alliance team is continuing with the kerb and channel work and widening of the road shoulder on Cranford Street.

From **this Thursday 12 September** we will be installing the new kerbs, a new footpath and widening the road shoulder on Cranford Street, between Weston Road and McFaddens Road.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

There will be no entry heading east from Weston Road onto Cranford Street. See map overleaf. Access onto Weston Road from Cranford Street will still be possible.

During this work there will be a footpath diversion in place and there will be no on-street parking available near the work sites.

Vehicle access to the businesses and residential properties will be maintained.

To ensure the kerb pour can continue as planned, please don't park in the no-parking area.

WHAT'S NEXT?

From **Monday 23 September** there will be a no-entry on Knowles Street to accommodate the kerb construction. Similar to the no-entry on Weston Road, you cannot enter Cranford Street from Knowles Street.

Following the kerb work, the relocation of power cables and storm water work, we will construct the footpath and widen the road shoulder. Once work is complete we will remove the no-entry at Weston Road and Knowles Street.

Early October we will remove the closures at Weston Road and Knowles Street and there will be a no-entry from McFaddens Road to Cranford Street to accommodate the kerb work here.

Mid-October we start work on the actual road surface. This means new asphalt and installing the planted central median that will make McFaddens Road, Weston Road and Knowles Streets left in and out only. More on this in our next update.


