NIGHT WORK CRANFORD STREET

On **Monday evening 9 December**, the crew will asphalt on Cranford Street and Innes Road in front of Kidd's Cakes and Bakery. We are doing this work at night to allow customers unrestricted access during the day from Cranford Street into the bakery's driveways and parking lot.

Nearby residents will hear the noise from the machinery and the crew working at night.

From Sunday evening/night 15 December to Tuesday night 17 December, we will install new traffic signals and ducting on all corners of the Cranford/Innes intersection and remove the old street light poles and signals. We can then commission the new street light poles and new traffic signals hanging over the road.

Traffic impact

Traffic on Cranford Street and Innes Road intersection will shift lanes.

You will still be able to turn left and right into Cranford Street from Innes Road and vice versa, however you will need to drive in the straight through lane and indicate your turn.

Please take care and once again thank you for your ongoing patience and cooperation while we upgrade the Cranford Street and Innes Road intersection.



When the existing street light pole (right in the photo) has been removed, we can turn the new gantry into the right position (over the road) and turn on the new street lights and traffic signals.
