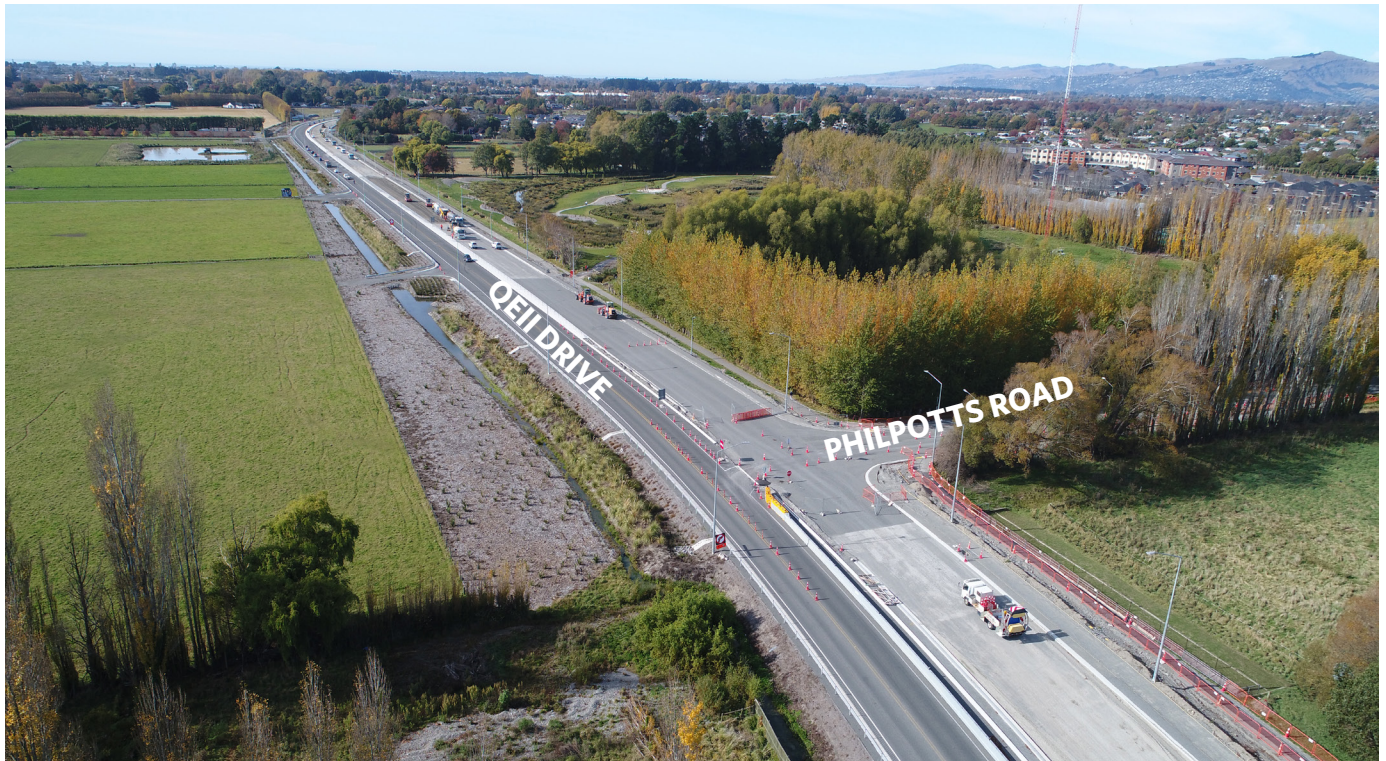


Christchurch Northern Corridor Philpotts Road

PROJECT UPDATE

25 MAY 2020



ONE DAY CLOSURE PHILPOTTS RD/QEII DRIVE INTERSECTION

The left out lane from Philpotts Road onto QEII Drive will be closed to all traffic for one day from **7am to 7pm on Friday 29 May**. The Christchurch Northern Corridor (CNC) Alliance team will complete the road surface at the new intersection that ties in with the new lanes on QEII Drive.

Traffic Impact

When the Philpotts Road intersection is closed, you can either use Innes Road or Main North Road to access QEII Drive.

Cyclists and pedestrians will be able to continue from Philpotts Road onto the QEII Drive temporary shared use path as normal, by following the fenced off path and signage. The intersection will open again after this work to left out only onto QEII Drive.

Construction Impact

After the asphaltting we will be painting the lines and installing new give-way signage. Asphaltting is weather dependent, so the closure could be a day later than now planned. We want to thank you again for your patience and cooperation while we complete the QEII Drive upgrade.

What's next?

Unfortunately the COVID-19 lock down period has delayed the opening of the upgraded QEII Drive, between Innes Road roundabout and Main North Road.

From early July, the new permanent lay out (left in and out only) at the Philpotts Road and QEII Drive intersection will be in place. This happens after we switch the traffic onto the new lanes. We will update you on this closer to the time.

To enter the garden centre at 116 Philpotts Road, take Innes Road to turn onto Philpotts Road.

QEII Drive with the motorway overbridge and the roundabouts. When the roundabouts are complete travellers turning left out of Philpotts Road can do a U-turn at the first roundabout.



ACCESS TO QEII DRIVE

Between 7am and 7pm on Friday 29 May you will need to take either Innes Road or Cranford Street and Main North Road to access QEII Drive.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

- Our standard construction work hours are Monday to Saturday between 7am and 7pm. Night work usually starts after 7pm and stops before 6am.
- There will be increased noise and vibrations associated with most of the construction work. We will do what we can to minimise this.
- Keep yourself and your children, as well as pets, at a safe distance from the work site. Please stay behind the construction fences at all times.
- All work sites are subject to weather and other unforeseen conditions. Some jobs will finish early while others may be delayed or rescheduled.
