

Project update

August 2017



The CNC Alliance team is building the new motorway and the four lane upgrade to QELi Drive and Cranford Street.

Construction of the Cranford Street upgrade is planned for January 2018 and will be done in stages:

- relocating underground services
- removing and pouring new kerbs
- building new road
- building new footpaths.

Per stage we will work on one side of the road in small areas so it provides the least amount of impact to the whole street.

Before we start the main construction we need to get the street ready for the changes. This work will start in September.

New lay out plans showing and explaining the changes to Cranford Street are printed overleaf. We will provide you with more details about the timing and staging of this work in the next few weeks.

In the meantime we would like to meet with you to consult on vehicle access to your property and gaining approval on trimming trees and planting on your boundary.

TREES AND PLANTING ON THE BOUNDARY

To enable construction on Cranford Street we will soon need to establish our work areas. As the entire width of Cranford Street will be used to construct four traffic lanes any vegetation on berms and overhanging tree branches will need to be removed or trimmed back. If tree cutting or removal is necessary, it will be done by a Council approved arborist and is at no cost to you.

PROPERTY ACCESS

In the New Year while we are working on Cranford Street we will need to build new kerbs and move underground services like power, water, sewerage and telecommunication. This will mean that at times vehicle access to your property will not be possible during the day as we will be working in front of your driveway. Let us know if you have any specific access requirements that we need to consider like Meals on Wheels or planned work on your property/moving house.

WORKING ON OR NEAR YOUR PROPERTY

For the vegetation removal and tree cutting we will be working close to your property boundary or in some cases we may need to work on your property close to the boundary fence. Please let us know if you have any animals loose on the property or any other safety concerns we should be aware of.

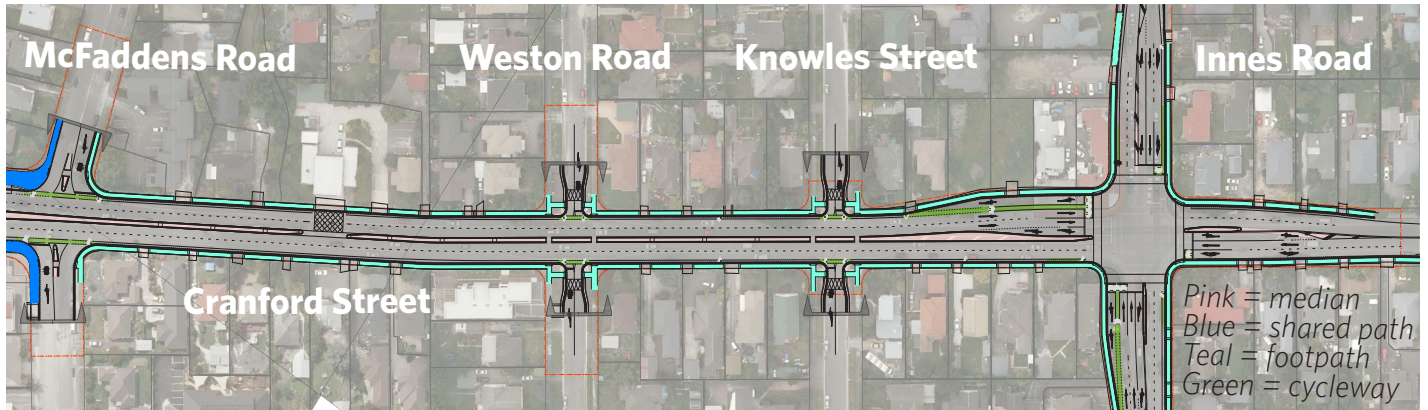

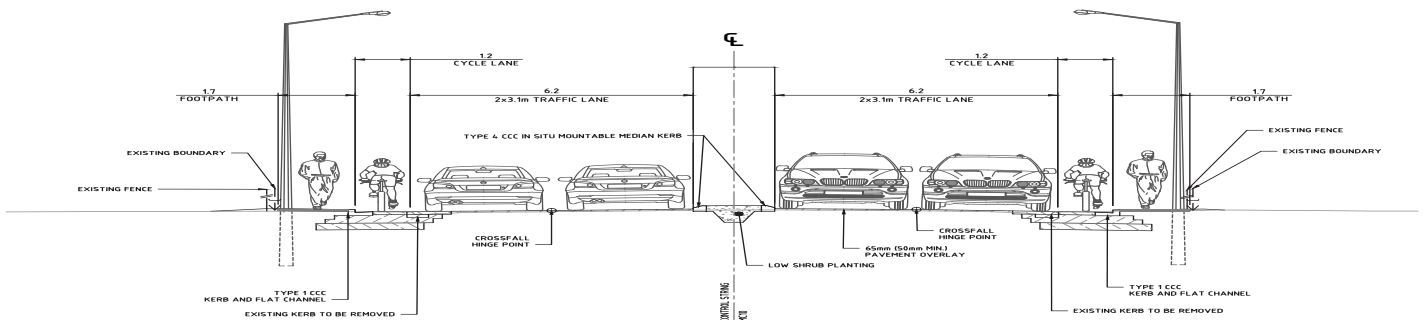

The design of Cranford Street between the Christchurch Northern Corridor connection and Innes Road is being upgraded to include four traffic lanes and a central median.

The Cranford Street/Innes Road intersection will be widened and turning lanes and signals will be improved. The central median along Cranford Street will improve safety by removing right turns at Knowles Street, Weston Road and McFaddens Road, and by reducing the possibility of front-on collisions on Cranford Street. The median will also reduce delays and stop commuters using suburban streets as rat-runs or shortcuts. While this may mean a longer drive for local residents, the median will improve safety and reduce through traffic on local roads.

North of McFaddens Road, Cranford Street will have some turning bays for U-turns and a shared cycle/footpath. The road narrows south of McFaddens Road so on-road cycle lanes will be provided along with a footpath on each side of the road. There will be no on-street parking on either side of Cranford Street.
