

# Project update

## Cranford Street/Innes Road - night works



The CNC Alliance team is working at night due to the high traffic volumes during the day.

Working at night means that the traffic team will set up the cones to shift some of the traffic lanes from 6pm.

Work will start around 7pm. By 5am the next morning the crew will have finished their shift and the temporary traffic management will be removed.

Residents living close to the intersection will hear some noise and may notice extra light coming from the street.

We apologise for the inconvenience and thank you for your understanding and your patience while we work on the Cranford Street Upgrade.



### INSTALLING 32 DUCTS AROUND THE INTERSECTION

To upgrade and relocate the underground services we will need to install ducts. The ducts are used for new telecommunication lines, new traffic signals and to future proof new power cables. We are installing 32 ducts in total, on all sides of the Cranford Street and Innes Road intersection. This work will take between five and ten nights.

### CONSTRUCTION IMPACT

We will be digging small trenches on traffic lanes to install the ducts. The crew will dig a section of the road up, place the ducts, fill the trench and reinstate the road before the morning commute starts. There will be some noise from trucks, the excavator and the crew working overnight. We need to use concrete cutters at times, we try to get the cutting done in the early evening. Before we reinstate the road we will need to use a compactor, this can be noisy as well and you may feel ground vibrations if you live close to the work site. The crew need lights to see what they are working on; you may notice extra light coming from the street.

### TRAFFIC IMPACT

Our work site will occupy one traffic lane each time we dig a trench so we will have to shift the traffic on that lane to the other lane. Two-way traffic flow will be maintained. Part of the footpath next to our work area will be temporarily closed. Please follow the traffic signs to use the footpath on the other side.

### WHEN IS THIS HAPPENING?

The work will start on **Sunday 19 November** and will be completed within 10 nights. Each night we will work from 7pm till 5am.
