## LANE CLOSURES ON SH1 SOUTHBOUND - EXPECT SLOW TRAFFIC

Nightly from **Monday night 23 September for about a month**, we will close one traffic lane southbound on SH1, between Tram Road and the Waimakariri Bridge. The Tram Road on-ramp stays open as normal during the night work.

### Traffic Impact

SH1 southbound traffic, between Tram Road and the bridge, will be reduced to one lane from 6pm to 5.30am, every night except Friday and Saturday nights. We are installing new service cables for street lights, traffic signals, telecommunication and power. During the lane closures there will be a **60km/h speed limit** in place. Please follow the signs and reduce your speed.

Due to the ongoing work on SH1 and the Waimakariri Bridge there is currently a 80km/h speed limit in place over the bridge at all other times.

### Construction Impact

New service cables will be installed using an excavator to dig a trench, install the cable, then backfill the trench. A small crew is working at night on this, they will do roughly 100m at a time. The crew will start just before Tram Road and work southbound towards the Waimakariri Bridge. It will take a month to complete the work. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.
