PHILPOTTS ROAD OPENING TO LEFT IN

The Christchurch Northern Corridor (CNC) Alliance is nearing the completion of the QEII Drive upgrade. Westbound traffic, between Innes Road roundabout and Winters Road, has been shifted this week onto the newly upgraded lanes.

While the new westbound lanes on QEII Drive looked ready for traffic, we could only move to these lanes once we have had some warmer drier weather, allowing the chip seal layer to warm up and bed in.

Winter is not the best time to be doing this sort of work but unfortunately the Covid-19 shutdown has pushed this project into the winter months. Our sincere apologies that this work has taken longer than original anticipated.

What's next?

The bedding in of the chip seal layer on the new lanes is going well so far. After the weekend we will complete our work at Philpotts Road so we can open this road to its final lay out, left in and out only from QEII Drive, early next week.
