WORKING TOWARDS THE REOPENING OF CHANEYS ON-RAMP

On the weekend beginning **Friday evening 18 October**, two-way traffic on Main North Road, near the closed Chaneys on-ramp, will be managed without the temporary traffic lights. This will help with ease of traffic flow while a concrete pour takes place at the Waimakariri Bridge.

Between **Monday 21 October until Friday 1 November** the traffic lights are back on again. From Friday evening 1 November, two-way traffic on Main North Road will return to normal. On **Wednesday evening 6 November** the Chaneys on-ramp will reopen to traffic.

With the re-opening of the ramp, traffic will be able to turn left from Marshland Road onto Main North Road from Wednesday 6 November.

Please note:

From 6pm on Friday 1 November we are sealing the new lane on SH1 that connects to the new CNC motorway. For the sealing (foam bitumen stabilisation) work we will close one northbound lane on SH1, between the Western Belfast Bypass and the Waimakariri Bridge.

The lane reduction will stay in place till 4pm on Monday 4 November. For the safety of the road users and workers, there will be a temporary 30km/h speed limit in place on this part of SH1 during the work and while the gravel remains loose.



The Chaneys on-ramp will be open from Wednesday evening 6 November.
