NIGHT WORK CRANFORD STREET

From **7pm Sunday evening 23 February till Friday morning 28 February**, we will install the new traffic signals at night on all corners of the Cranford Street and Innes Road intersection and remove the old street light poles and signals. We can then commission the new street light poles and new traffic signals hanging over the road. The installation involves deep excavation.

Construction impact

This work involves concrete cutting (early in the evening), excavations and truck movements. Nearby residents will hear the noise from the machinery and the crew working at night. The crew need lights to see what they are working on, so you may notice extra light coming from the road.

Traffic impact

Traffic on Cranford Street and Innes Road intersection will shift lanes each evening/night. You will still be able to turn left and right into Cranford Street from Innes Road and vice versa, all traffic will be on the straight through lanes, so indicate your turn. **On Thursday night 27 February all the traffic lights will be out and the intersection will function as a roundabout: you must give way to all traffic that will cross your path from your right.** Please take care, and once again thank you for your ongoing patience and cooperation while we upgrade the Cranford Street and Innes Road intersection.



The new gantries will be put into the right positions over the road once the existing poles are removed.
