## CRANFORD STREET: LINE MARKING AND CONCRETE POURS

We are nearly there - from **9pm Monday evening 23 March**, we will install the lines on the road at the Innes Road and Cranford Street intersection. And we will be building the new medians on both sides of Cranford Street and on the west side of Innes Road. We expect we will have the line marking complete over four nights. We are close to commissioning the new right turn traffic signals. Once the traffic light poles are installed in the new medians, we can turn them on. This will happen overnight in early April. Thursday night 26 March we will putting asphalt around the service manhole covers in the middle of the intersection.

### Construction impact

This work involves a small crew with a line marking machine. Nearby residents may hear some noise from the machine and the crew working at night. The crew need lights, so you may notice extra light coming from the road. Concrete pours for the medians could happen as early as 3am, you will hear the truck and the crew working on the medians. It will not be as bad as the milling and sealing work.

### Traffic impact

Due to the traffic impact this work needs to happen at night and early morning. Traffic on Cranford Street and Innes Road intersection will shift lanes each evening/night. **There is a road closure at night on Thursday 26 March on Innes Road east at the Cranford Street intersection. See diversion map overleaf.**
