KERB AND CHANNEL WORK - NO ENTRY MCFADDENS ROAD NORTHBOUND

The Christchurch Northern Corridor (CNC) Alliance team is making good progress with the kerb and channel work that started in early January this year.

From Wednesday 13 March we will be installing the new kerbs on the east side of Cranford Street. We start at the McFaddens Road intersection and move south.

Following the McFaddens intersection work we will construct the section between Knowles Street and Innes Road.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

From Wednesday 13 March for around two weeks there will be no entry into McFaddens Road northbound (Cranford Oak Motel side).

A diversion via Weston Road will be in place. Traffic will be able to exit left out of McFaddens Road.

The bus stop near the McFaddens Road corner will be temporarily closed, an interim bus stop will be available in front of 300 Cranford Street.

During this work there will be a footpath diversion in place and there will be no on-street parking available near the work sites. Vehicle access to the businesses and residential properties will be maintained.

To ensure work can continue as programmed please avoid parking in areas where no-parking cones have been placed.

When we are working in front of Kidds Bakery we will have late afternoon dig outs and early morning concrete pours. This is so we don't interrupt driveway access to these businesses during opening hours.

From mid-March we are starting **night work** to install new storm water pipes across Cranford Street near McFaddens Road and across the Innes Road intersection. More information on this overleaf.

NIGHT WORKS - PIPE INSTALLATION

From mid-March we have to work four nights to install storm water pipes across Cranford Street first near McFaddens Road. In mid-April we will work nights to install two pipes across the Innes Road intersection.

During this work the traffic at night will shift a lane and the shoulder and footpath will be closed. Diversions will be in place for pedestrians.

We will be using concrete cutters (early evening use), excavators and compactors to dig a trench, place the pipe, then fill in and reseal the trench.

There will be some noise from the machinery and the crew working overnight. The crew need lights to see what they are working on, so you may notice extra light coming from the road.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

- › Our regular working hours are Monday to Saturday between 7am and 7pm.
- › There will be noise and vibrations associated with the work we have to do. We will do what we can to lessen this.
- › Keep yourself, your children and pets at a safe distance from the work site. Please stay behind the construction fences at all times.
- › All work sites are subject to weather and other unforeseen conditions.
