Traffic Impact

Two way traffic on Cranford Street will be maintained by moving traffic from one side to the other and by using the shoulder. Please follow the on road signs and reduce your speed. To ensure work can continue as programmed please avoid parking in areas where no-parking cones have been placed.

Construction Impact

This work involves excavation, concrete cutting, compacting and sealing. We will use concrete cutters (early evening use) and excavators to dig a trench, place the pipes and pour concrete. During the curing time for the concrete steel plates will cover the trench. Once the concrete is set, we backfill the trench, compact it and reseal it.

Nearby residents may hear the noise from the machinery and the crew working at night. The crew need lights to see what they are working on, so you may notice extra light coming from the road.

Following the storm water works and constructing the new kerbs and footpaths we will install new traffic signals and signs, construct the central median and install the final surfacing late in 2019. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.
