KERB AND CHANNEL WORK - NO ENTRY KNOWLES STREET EASTBOUND

The Christchurch Northern Corridor (CNC) Alliance team is moving to the other side of Cranford Street to start the kerb and channel work and widen the road shoulder.

From **Monday 29 July** we will be installing the new kerbs on Cranford Street, opposite Kidds Bakery, between Innes Road and Knowles Street.

We start at the Innes Road intersection. Following this we will construct the section between Knowles Street and Weston Road.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

From Monday 29 July until Friday 23 August there will be no entry heading east from Knowles Street onto Cranford Street. See map overleaf. Turning onto Knowles Street from Cranford Street will still be possible.

The bus stop on Cranford Street near the intersection with Innes Road will be temporarily closed, an interim bus stop will be available in front of 263 Cranford Street.

During this work there will be a footpath diversion in place and there will be no on-street parking available near the work sites.

Vehicle access to the businesses and residential properties will be maintained.

To ensure work can continue as programmed please avoid parking in areas where no-parking cones have been placed.

There is also a crew upgrading the storm water system on Cranford Street and on Innes Road. This work will also progress over the next two months.
