ROAD LAYOUT CHANGES AT CRANFORD STREET ROUNDABOUT

The Christchurch Northern Corridor (CNC) Alliance team is starting work on Cranford Street next to the new roundabout that will connect the new CNC motorway with Cranford Street. To do this work two way traffic on Cranford Street will shift onto the new roundabout lanes.

Traffic Impact


To remove the existing road and construct a shared pedestrian and cycle path we will move all traffic onto the new roundabout lanes. On **Monday night**17 February southbound traffic will shift onto the roundabout lane. A week later on Sunday night 23 February northbound traffic will also shift onto the roundabout lanes. There will be a temporary 30km/h speed limit in place.

Cyclists can merge with the traffic choosing to take the roundabout lanes or preferably use the shared use path next to the existing northbound lane.

When the motorway opens later this year, drivers on the motorway heading south to the city can pass safely to the left of the roundabout onto Cranford Street.

There will be a signalised crossing (red circle) to connect the CNC shared use path with the path on Cranford Street. The blue lines on the design plan show the paths.
