SURFACE WORKS ON QEII DRIVE AND MAIN NORTH ROAD INTERSECTION

To complete the upgrade of the westbound lanes on QEII Drive we are resurfacing near the Main North Road intersection.

The work will start from **Friday 15 May till Monday afternoon 18 May**. As this work is weather dependent it could take another day.

Traffic Impact

During the work over the weekend westbound traffic is reduced to one lane just before the intersection traffic lights. This will increase the queueing time. Traffic from Northcote Road turning onto Main North Road is not affected.

If you are travelling on QEII Drive please expect delays near the Main North Road intersection, slow down near the work site and take extra care. There is a temporary 50km/h speed limit in place during our works and while the gravel remains loose the speed limit will be reduced to 30km/h.

Construction Impact

For the resurfacing we use foam bitumen stabilisation, which involves large trucks and heavy machinery. We will also apply chip seal. In between the foaming and chip sealing, the cement needs to harden for one or two days. No work will be happening then, however the traffic management stays in place. Nearby residents will hear the noise from the machinery and the crew working.

Please note that the asphalt will be applied after the chip seal has been in use for a year.



Please expect delays just before the Main North Road intersection on QEII Drive over the weekend.
