ROAD RESURFACE WORK AT NIGHT

The Christchurch Northern Corridor (CNC) Alliance team will be starting the road resurfacing work at the QEII Drive and Innes Road roundabout. From **Sunday night 14 June**, we will be milling and asphalting for several nights and on 21 June we will be finishing the kerbs and drainage on the island.

Paving work is planned on: Sunday 14, Monday 15, Wednesday 17, Thursday 18 and Sunday 28, Monday 29, Tuesday 30 June and Wednesday 1, Thursday 2 and Sunday 5 July. We need dry weather conditions for this work so we may need to extend these nights.

Milling the road is noisy, nearby residents will hear the noise from the machinery and the crew working at night.

TRAFFIC IMPACT

During the night work, when we are paving, the roundabout will be closed to westbound traffic. Westbound traffic on QEII Drive will be diverted at the roundabout via Innes Road, Cranford Street and Main North Road.

QEII Drive eastbound traffic can drive straight through on the slip lane but cannot turn right at the roundabout to go to Innes Road.

Traffic on Innes Road cannot enter the QEII Drive roundabout, a diversion via Hills Road, Briggs Road, Marshland Road and Prestons Road will be in place.

Please expect delays due to the lane reductions and closure of the roundabout.

DIVERSIONS ROUNDABOUT CLOSURE

During the night works on the QEII Drive/Innes Road roundabout eastbound traffic cannot turn right at the roundabout to go to Innes Road, traffic on Innes Road cannot enter the roundabout and westbound traffic will be diverted.

Diversion will be in place via Marshland Road, Briggs Road and Hills Road and Innes Road, Cranford Street and Main North Road. Traffic on Innes Road will be diverted at Hills Road via Prestons Road to head westbound.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

- Our standard construction work hours are Monday to Saturday between 7am and 7pm. Night work starts after 7pm and stops before 6am.
- > There will be increased noise and vibrations associated with most of the construction work. We will do what we can to minimise this.
- > Keep yourself and your children, as well as pets, at a safe distance from the work site. Please stay behind the construction fences at all times.
- All work sites are subject to weather and other unforeseen conditions. Some jobs will finish early while others may be delayed or rescheduled.
