

# Christchurch Northern Corridor QEII Drive night work

## NIGHT WORK AT INNES ROAD ROUNDABOUT, HILLS RD CLOSURE

The Christchurch Northern Corridor (CNC) Alliance team will be completing paving and landscaping work on the QEII Drive/Innes Road roundabout upgrade. From **Sunday night 1 November** detours will be used and the Hills Road/QEII Drive intersection will need to close.

**Night work at the roundabout is planned for each night on Sunday 1 November and from Sunday 15 to Thursday night 19 November.** The Hills Road intersection will be closed from Monday 9 through to Friday 13 November.

The work involves milling and paving machines, trucks and diggers. We will be milling and asphaltting, installing wire rope barriers, landscaping the islands and painting the lines on the road.

Nearby residents will hear the noise from the machinery and the crew working at night. We will try to do the noisiest work early in the night.

### TRAFFIC IMPACT

During the night work on 1 and between 15 and 19 November the eastbound and westbound roundabout lane will be closed. QEII Drive eastbound traffic can drive straight through on the slip lane but cannot turn right at the roundabout to go to Innes Road. Diversions will be in place. Please follow the on-road signage and consider taking Prestons Road as an alternate.

On Wednesday 18 November the slip lane to turn left onto Innes Road will be closed. Traffic from Innes Road can still enter the roundabout to head westbound on QEII Drive.

To complete the paving work at Hills Road, the intersection will be closed from 9 to 13 November.

The night work is planned from 9pm to 5am. The asphaltting work is weather dependent so may take longer than planned.
