SH1 LANE CLOSURES AT NIGHT FOR RESURFACING WORK

The Christchurch Northern Corridor (CNC) Alliance is ready to stabilise and re-seal SH1 just north and south of the Waimakariri Bridge.

This work will start from **Sunday night 18 October** and continue until late November.

Traffic impact

North and southbound traffic on SH1 will be reduced to one lane each night to enable this work.

Work starts in the north and southbound right-hand lanes and will then move to the middle lanes and finally the left-hand lanes.

What are we doing?

We start with foam bitumen stabilisation, which creates a strong but flexible base layer. This is done using a train made up of a bitumen tanker, a milling machine and a water cart. We will then chip seal the road. In between the foaming and chip sealing, the surface needs to harden for several days.

The final stage of sealing the road is laying the asphalt surface. In some areas this will need to wait until the chip seal has been down for about a year.

A **60km/h speed limit** will be in place during the night work. This work should not create any significant delay overnight. Northbound lane reduction times are 7pm to 7am. Southbound reduction times are 6pm to 5.30am.
