SH1-CONTRAFLOW ON WAIMAKARIRI BRIDGE

The Christchurch Northern Corridor (CNC) Alliance is lifting more beams into place on the Waimakariri Bridge over the weekend. To do this work we need to contraflow traffic over the bridge.

On Friday and Saturday night (16 and 17 August) from 6pm to 6am we will close the southbound bridge and put both north and southbound traffic onto the northbound bridge one lane in each direction.

For the safety of the road users and workers, there will be a temporary 60km/h speed limit in place along the work site during this night work. Please note there is already a temporary 80km/h speed limit in place during the day.

TRAM ROAD OFF-RAMP NIGHT CLOSURES

We need to close the Tram Road off-ramp and the left traffic lane on SH1 for four nights next week to install cables for future street lights.

On the nights of Sunday 18 to Wednesday 21 from 7pm to 7am Tram Road off-ramp will be closed and SH1 will be reduced to one lane from the Waimakariri Bridge to just beyond Tram Road.

Tram Road off-ramp users will need to continue up to the Ohoka Road off-ramp and follow the posted detour via Island Road.
