LANE CLOSURES ON SH1 NORTHBOUND - EXPECT SLOW TRAFFIC

On **Thursday 25 and Friday 26 July during the day and Sunday 28 and Monday 29 July at night**, we will close one traffic lane northbound on SH1 just south of the Waimakariri Bridge.

Traffic Impact

SH1 northbound traffic will be reduced to one lane during the day (5am to 1pm) on Thursday 25 and Friday 26 July. We are asphaltting the new shoulder lane. This will function as a temporary road so we can work on the widening in the middle reserve area. During night work on Sunday 28 and Monday 29 July the traffic is again reduced to one lane. Part of the SH1 shoulder where we are working will remain closed till late September this year.

During the lane closures there will be a **30km/h speed limit** in place. Please follow the signs, stay within traffic cones and reduce your speed. Due to the ongoing work on SH1 and the Waimakariri Bridge there is currently a 80km/h speed limit in place.

Construction Impact

During the day shifts we are asphaltting the new lane, late this year the shoulder lane and the widening will receive their final layer of asphalt so it connects the new CNC motorway with SH1. During the night work we will be line marking and shifting the steel safety barriers. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.
