WINTERS ROAD OFF-RAMP TEMPORARILY CLOSED

The Christchurch Northern Corridor (CNC) Alliance team is temporarily closing the Winters Road off-ramp from Monday 8 March.

We have to work on the motorway barriers, and to keep our workers and the road users in this area safe we need to close this lane.

Traffic Impact

The Winters Road off-ramp, between Cranford Street and Winters Road, will be closed for two weeks from Monday 8 March, every working day between 6am and 4pm. People driving on Cranford Street during the closure times can use Innes Road or Main North Road to access QEII Drive. People wishing to access Winters Road can use Fraser Street.

People on Winters Road can continue to use the off-ramp (turn left out of Winters Road) to enter the QEII Drive interchange as normal.

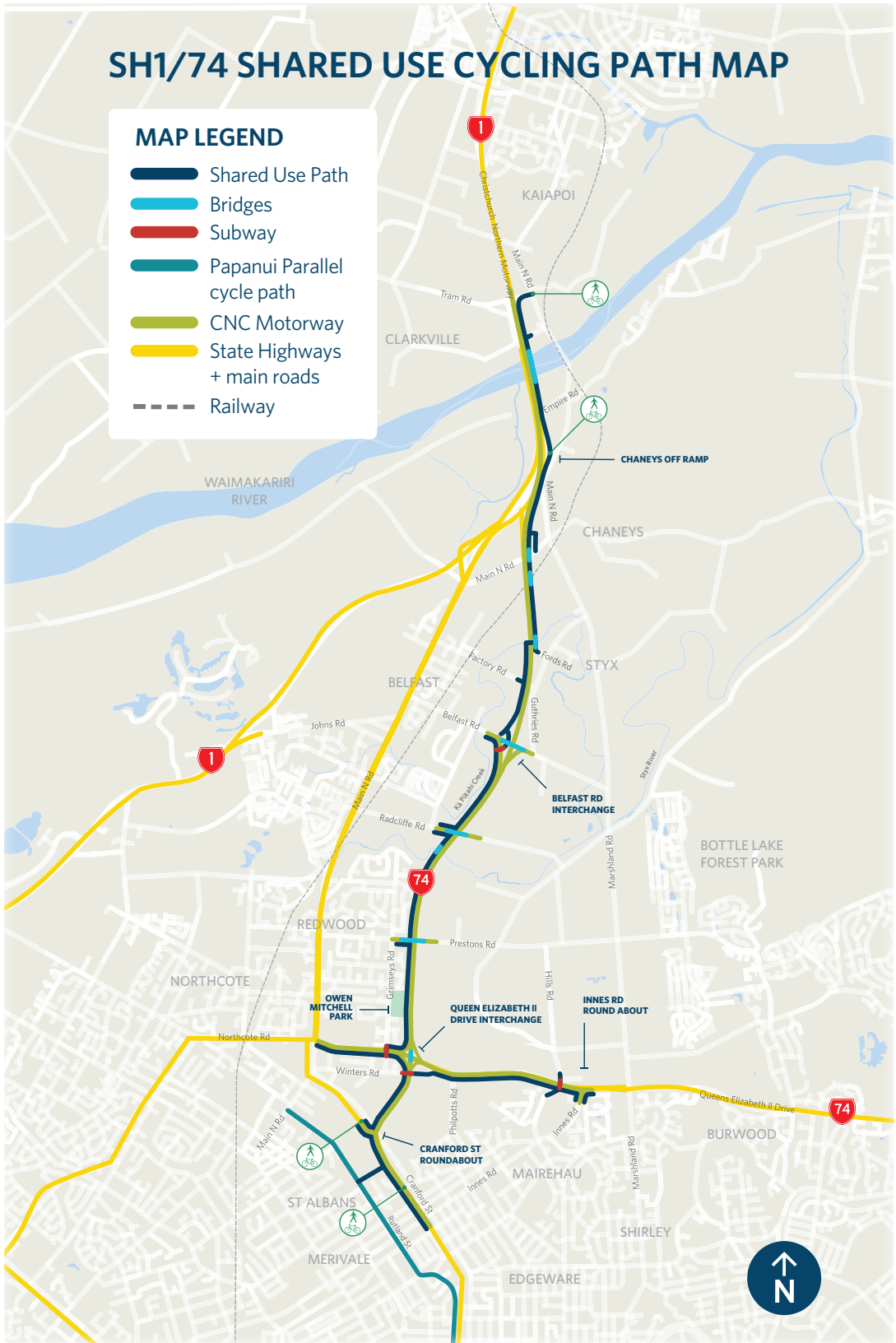

The shared path runs along the CNC motorway from Cranford Street in St Albans to the Tram Road and Main North Road intersection north of the Waimakariri Bridge. The shared cycleway route north of this intersection, through to Kaiapo, runs along the western side of Main North Road.
