NIGHT WORK ON SH1 - LANE CLOSURE - EXPECT SLOW TRAFFIC

From **Wednesday night 3 July for seven nights,** we will close one traffic lane northbound on SH1 just south of the Waimakariri Bridge.

Traffic Impact

SH1 northbound traffic will be reduced to one lane at night (7pm to 7am) from 3 until 9 July. On Thursday 4 and Friday 5 July the one lane reduction stays in place till 11am for chipsealing. Following this work traffic will shift onto this new chip seal lane. Part of the SH1 shoulder will remain closed till late September this year. See maps overleaf.

During the lane closures there will be a **30km/h speed limit** in place. Please follow the signs, stay within traffic cones and reduce your speed. Due to the ongoing work during the day there is currently a 80km/h speed limit in place.

Construction Impact

We are widening the road so we can connect the new CNC motorway lanes with SH1. This work will include earthworks, installation of drainage pipes, utilities, barriers, road and swale construction and landscaping.
