

Mill Road timeline

Manukau City Council began consultation on the northern section.

2009

Auckland Transport held further consultation, completed route identification of the northern section and lodged Notices of Requirement.

2012-15

Te Tupu Ngātahi Supporting Growth developed transport plans supporting 30 years of Auckland growth and engaged on the southern transport network including southern sections of Mill Road.

2015-18

After funding was received as part of the New Zealand Upgrade Programme, public engagement and site investigations were undertaken along the corridor.

2020

NZTA will provide further updates on the status of the Mill Road project as it continues.

2024

The Roads of National Significance programme announced construction funding for Stage 1 and route protection for Stages 2 and 3 as part of the GPS 2024.

2022-23

While planning and investigative work progressed, no funding was allocated for construction.

2021

Cost escalations resulted in a change of scope. The Manukau to Takaanini access and safety project instead focused on improvements within the existing corridor.
