This information outlines what you can expect during the remainder of Stage 1 work on Gray and McBride Streets



What	Notice of excavation for power undergrounding
When	Mid-September, and then early-mid October 2024
Where	McBride Street, between the intersection with Gray Street and SH6A Frankton Road

What's happening?

We're continuing our trenching work at McBride Street to underground power services for the SH6/6A Frankton Intersection and Bus Hub Improvements Project.

We'll start on the eastern side of the road (see diagram top right). Traffic will flow one way, towards SH6A Frankton Road. Parking will be reduced in parts of McBride Street so that both traffic flow and construction can happen safely together. We will then move to the other side of the road (see diagram bottom right).


Gray Street is open from SH6 Kawarau Road. Parking is available in the Gray Street public carpark. Traffic staff will guide people in and out of private driveways.

We've planned it this way to keep oneway traffic flowing along McBride Street, and so people can get to the Frankton shops and use the Gray Street carpark.



Access restrictions

On-street parking will be temporarily unavailable on parts of McBride Street (see maps above), with alternative parking available at the public carpark nearby.



Timing

The excavation work will take place for about two weeks, from:

Mid-September, and then early-mid October 2024
Work will take place during the day.



Traffic management

When we need to excavate through a driveway, we will have steel plates on hand to place over the trench to get vehicles through, and traffic staff on hand to guide vehicles and pedestrians through safely.
