# This information outlines what you can expect during the remainder of Stage 1 work on McBride and Ross Streets



What	Notice of excavation for undergrounding services, including night work
When	Sunday 1 - Thursday 5 September, and Monday 9 - Friday 27 September 2024
Where	Ross Street and the intersection with McBride Street, and adjacent to SH6 Kawarau Road

# What's happening?

We're upgrading utilities along State Highway 6 and 6A and local roads for the Frankton Intersection and Bus Hub Improvements Project. We'll soon be trenching across Ross Street and McBride Street, laying electrical and fibre optic cable. We'll need to partially close this intersection at night while we carry out this work. The rest of the work is in the shoulder of the road and footpath only.



## What can I expect?

- From Sunday 1 to Thursday 5 September, firstly Ross Street and then a section of McBride Street will be closed from 10pm to 6am as we trench across these roads (shown in orange on the diagram above).
- Saw cutting and hydrovac trucks will be used. We'll carry out noisier work earlier in the evening, and vehicle reversing alarms won't be high-pitched to reduce disruption to residents.
- From Monday 9 through to Friday 27 September, we'll be working in the verge and the footpath on Ross/McBride Streets (shown in yellow), followed by McBride Street (in green), and then adjacent to SH6 Kawarau Road (in teal).

# General information



## Planning

We appreciate any road closure is disruptive, however it's most disruptive to close the road during the day, therefore these works need to be completed at night. A full closure to traffic at night also means works can be completed more quickly - rather than multiple closures over an extended period.



### Access restrictions

When the roads are closed at night, access will remain for residents of the six affected properties using steel plates across their driveways.



#### **Timing**

The excavation work will take place over about four weeks, from:

Sunday 1 - Friday 27 September 2024



#### Traffic management

At the times when Ross Street and a section of McBride Street are closed, a short detour will be in place. Follow the signs and directions of crews.
