# What's happening?

## Day works:

We're starting on above-ground street rebuild works on the western end of Gray and McBride Streets during the day. On the side we are starting to rebuild kerbs, footpaths, roads and new street lighting will be installed.

# Night works:

A small portion of the SH6 Kawarau Road end of Gray Street will be closed to complete the connection of the upgraded water main that links back towards SH6/Ladies Mile. This work will be done over 2 nights but the area will remain closed during the day.

# What can I expect?

Day works: Saw cutting will be on the first day, then hydrovac trucks will be used before concreting will be done. Night works: Saw cutting and hydrovac trucks will be used. We'll carry out noisier work earlier in the evening to

minimise disruption to residents.

## General information



### **Planning**

We've planned it this way to allow for one way traffic on McBride Street, and to enable full access to the Frankton Village shops via the SH6 Kawarau Road end of Gray Street.



# Traffic management

The top part of Gray Street West, from McBride Street, will be closed. Traffic will be one-way only heading north on McBride Street, near the Gray Street intersection. Our Traffic Management team will be available to help with access to the driveways of The Doctors Whakatipu and Harbour Fish when required.

One footpath on each side of the road will remain open.



## Timing

- Night work to connect the upgraded water main will be done from 12 to 14 November. Work will be from 9pm to 6am but the road will remain closed during the day.
- Street rebuild rework will run from 4 November to 20
   December
- We will pause over Christmas New Year and start again on 6 January 2025
