

SH6/6A Frankton Intersection and Bus Hub Improvements Project

What	Notice for new carpark entrance construction
When	Monday 29 - Tuesday 30 July 2024 (two days)
Where	Gray-McBride Street Intersection

What's happening?

We're building a new entrance to the Gray Street carpark, near the Gray-McBride Street intersection, as part of the Frankton Intersection and Bus Hub Improvements Project.

This new entrance – on McBride Street - is needed so we can carry out later utilities and construction work at this intersection while maintaining access to Frankton Village for residents and businesses.

The Life's a Grind Espresso van will move 15m to the forecourt of Touchdown Car Rentals.

Moving underground utilities (power, water, fibre, and gas) as part of this project forms a large part of the first year of the construction programme for the Frankton Intersection and Bus Hub Improvements.

The Gray-McBride upgrade work is being done at the same time to minimise disruption if we need to return to this area in the future.

Timing

It will take the team two days to construct the new entrance. Work will be under way at these dates and times:

Planning

Traffic management

Temporary traffic measures will be in place as the new entrance is created.



Access restrictions

A section of on-street parking on McBride Street (see map above), will be temporarily unavailable during the work. Access to Gray-McBride Streets will be maintained.
