What's happening?






We're starting work on Gray Street as part of the SH6/6A Frankton Intersection and Bus Hub Improvements Project. We'll be managing access to part of Gray Street so excavation work can go ahead.

Access to the driveway into the Frankton Village shops will operate differently, depending on the work going on.

When excavation is underway, access to the driveway may be via the Gray Street carpark using the new entrance on McBride Street. At other times, drivers will be guided through the Gray Street construction area.

Timing

The excavation work will be underway at these dates and times:

- **Thursday 8 - Friday 30 August 2024**

All work will take place during the day.

Planning

We've planned it this way to keep Frankton Village driveway access open across Gray Street, causing the least disruption possible to residents and businesses. As a reminder, there is alternative public carparking off McBride Street.

Traffic management

There will be temporary traffic measures in place along Gray Street as work takes place – down to one lane – to help retain Frankton Village driveway access. Traffic using McBride Street will not be impacted.
