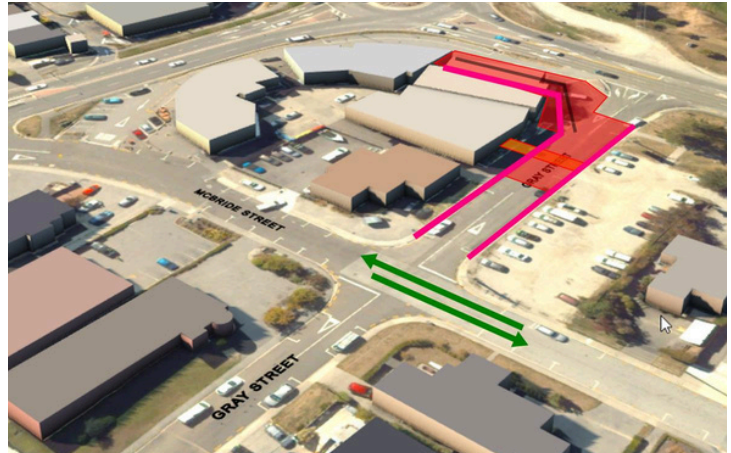
What	Notice of excavation for power connections at Frankton retail area
When	Wednesday 31 July - Wednesday 7 August 2024
Where	Gray Street and SH6 Kawarau Road, in front of Frankton Ale House

What's happening?






We're excavating around the corner of Gray Street and Kawarau Road, in front of Frankton Ale House, for the SH6/6A Frankton Intersection and Bus Hub Improvements Project.

We'll be managing pedestrian access to shops along Gray Street as we work in this area to establish a power connection to the Frankton shops.

We're aiming to keep one lane open for vehicles to enter the Frankton Village driveway. If we can't (due to the narrow work area) we'll need to close driveway access for one day, in consultation with residents and businesses. We'll plan to do this on a Sunday, when the retail centre is generally closed.

Timing

The excavation work will take place over one week, from:

- **Wednesday 31 July - Wednesday 7 August 2024**

Work will take place during the day.



Planning

We've planned it this way to make sure that driveway access to the Frankton Village retail area is maintained as much as possible. If we need to temporarily close the driveway, we'll do it on a Sunday to minimise disruption.



Traffic management

There will be temporary traffic measures in place. Follow signs and the directions of our crews to move around the area.



Access restrictions

On-street parking will be temporarily unavailable on either side of Gray Street (see map above). Drivers can use the new McBride Street entrance to the carpark. People walking between the carpark and the Frankton Village shops will be guided through the work area by our crews.
