



# Barters Road/Pound Road improvements

PROJECT UPDATE

March 2017

## Project overview

This project will improve the transport links between Pound Road and SH1, and improve safety at the SH1 Barters Road intersection and rail crossings.

It is designed to cater for future growth in the area and will make it safer and easier for motorists to enter and exit Main South Road from Pound Road and improve links for cyclists and pedestrians.

A new road will be built through the Waterloo Business Park with traffic lights at key intersections, shared cycle and pedestrian lanes, and a new railway crossing. Storm and wastewater work will also be carried out over the 15-month project.

The project is expected to be complete by the end of 2017.

Work on the State Highway 1 Barters Road/Pound Road improvements started in 2016 and is progressing well.

Over the past few months the contractor, Fulton Hogan, has been widening a section of SH1 Main South Road. The first stage of this work is complete and work is underway on the second stage in the centre of the road. A 50km/h speed restriction will be in place and there will be changes to the

road layout this month to allow the contractor to carry out this work.

During the work, people will be able to turn right off Main South Road and go to Little Sister cafe and The Swamp pub. There will be no on-street parking available directly around the work site.

## ROAD CLOSURES

The team are currently creating the new alignment of Waterloo Road and Pound Road, north of the rail line. Sections of both Waterloo Road and Pound Road will be closed to traffic from Monday March 20 until early April while this work is underway.

- Pound Road will be temporarily closed from 173 Pound Road to

the Pound Road/Waterloo Road intersection.

- Waterloo Road will be temporarily closed between the Islington Avenue and Halswell Junction Road.

Traffic will be detoured as shown on the maps below. Please allow extra travel time due to the detour.

### THE DETAILS

- Pound Road will be realigned to create a new signalised T intersection with SH1 immediately west of the Islington Tavern (via a new railway crossing).
- Waterloo Road will be realigned to create more space between the state highway and the rail corridor.
- A new intersection with traffic lights will be installed at Waterloo Road and Pound Road.
- The existing Barters Road railway crossing will be closed.

### GENERAL INFORMATION

The majority of the work will be carried out from Monday to Friday between 7:00am and 6:00pm.

Some work may occasionally be carried out on Saturdays if required.

Measures will be in place to minimise noise, dust and vibration levels.

All works are weather dependent.
