What are we doing?

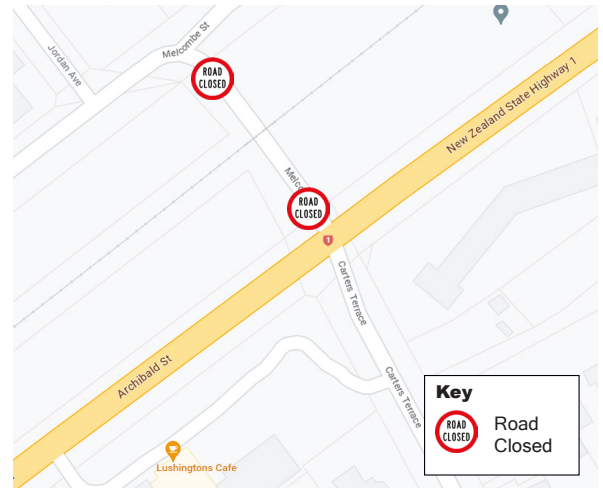
From Wednesday 10 January 2024, for approximately 5 weeks, we will be working on Melcombe Street (the Viaduct). Our works will include new kerb and channel and footpath construction, the installation of a pedestrian crossing, carriageway resurfacing and raised safety platform installation which requires Melcombe Street to be closed during this time, as shown below.

Traffic and pedestrian impacts

The road closure will be in place from Wednesday 10 January 2024 for approximately 5 weeks. There will be no access in or out during this time so please use the signposted detour routes.

Please look out for our staff and follow their instructions. Footpath access around our work site will be maintained.

Also, please look out for changes in traffic management and follow signs on site. A 30kph speed limit will be in place.



Other upgrades to Melcombe St, including the installation of raised safety platforms and cyclist separator strips, will be completed in the new year. These changes will help to keep cyclists safe and discourage vehicles from using Melcombe Street as a 'rat-run' to avoid the new traffic lights.

We are doing our best to give you accurate timeframes but unforeseen issues like weather, buried obstructions and unknown services can make work take longer. We're sorry for any disruption and thank you for your patience.
