## Forgotten World Highway improvements

NZ Transport Agency Waka Kotahi is delivering a \$30m programme of improvements to the Forgotten World Highway. With the community's support we've completed a significant amount of work over recent years.

## These improvements will:

- Make the road safer and easier to travel for locals and visitors.
- Reduce the occurrence of road closures during weather events.
- Make the road more efficient and reliable for freight.
- Encourage visitor flows from Tongariro National Park through to Egmont National Park.
- Bring more tourism to the area.

## What's been achieved?



New Kahouri **Stream Bridge and** road realignment constructed

Rest areas sealed, providing safe places for people to stop



**Moki Tunnel:** New signs erected warning drivers to look out for people on bikes



New bridge built at Pohokura, reinstating the road to two lanes

Tāngarākau Gorge: 7km of road sealed and 3 retaining walls built

More than **230** safety signs installed

20 trees which were roadside hazards or blocking sight lines removed
