





What are school speed zones?

There are two types of school speed zone, 'variable' and 'advisory'.

 **Electronic variable school zone signs** are an enforceable speed limit that can be activated during peak school traffic times.

The school zone speed limit may operate from 35 minutes before school until the start of school and from five minutes before school ends until 20 minutes after school ends. It may also operate for 10 minutes at any time when children cross the road or enter or leave vehicles at the roadside.

When the school zone is active the speed limit is 60km/h and will be display on an electronic sign, at all other times the speed limit is 80km/h.

 An **advisory school zone** is where a static speed sign is in place near a school, advising motorists to slow when children are present. The speed on these signs is not enforceable.
