

SH75 Halswell Road Improvements - Night Works Extension

What We'll be continuing to work overnight to replace and relocate pipes

Where Between 91a Halswell Road and 181 Halswell Road on the southbound side

When Sunday 4 August 2024, for about 2 weeks, between 7pm and 6am.

Our work is weather dependent and may need to be rescheduled to the following night(s).

What are we doing?

We need to continue to work at night for another two weeks starting from Sunday 4 August. Please see below for an update on the areas where we're working. As previously advised, this work will not affect the homes concerned, you'll be able to use your facilities as usual. We should only be working close to most properties for a few nights. Following concerns from some residents, we'll be using noise reduction barriers around our work area to help contain the noise. The work is being done at night when traffic volumes are lower to avoid congestion and disruption. It is also safer for our work crews and road users.

Please note - we will not work on Friday and Saturday nights.

Curletts Road to Tankerville Road

We've found that the main sewer pipe and connections were not what we expected and there was more concrete, which we needed to break through to connect the new sewer laterals (the pipes that carry sewage from property boundaries to the main sewer pipe in the road). Unfortunately, this has made the work more difficult to do. Our engineers are currently looking at solutions. Once it's resolved, we'll let residents in the area know what we're going to do.

Tankerville Road to 91 Halswell Road

The sewer laterals in this area have been replaced successfully.

91a Halswell Road to 181 Halswell Road

We'll be working in this area from Sunday 4 August, working south towards Hendersons Road.

Night works and what to expect

We know that night work is more disruptive to residents so we only do it when we have no other option to get the work done safely. When we work at night some noise from trucks, machinery and the crew is unavoidable. Our team will limit this as much as possible and we'll carry out the noisiest work early in the shift. We'll also be using noise reduction barriers around our work site. The crews also need lights to see what they are working on so you may notice extra light in the area.

Traffic and pedestrian impacts

During our work hours, traffic will be reduced to one lane through the area we're working in. Temporary traffic lights will be used to manage traffic through the work area. Please look out for our staff and follow their instructions. Footpath access around our work site will be maintained. Parking will be unavailable both on Halswell Road and on the grass berms in the area we're working in. Bus stops may be temporarily closed where we're working, please follow the instructions on the signage provided at the closed stop. Also, please look out for changes in traffic management and follow signs on site. A 30km/h speed limit will be in place.

Driveway access

Access to properties will be maintained. However, we may need to work in front of driveways from time to time. If you need to get into or out of your property and we're in the way, please just talk to one of our friendly staff and we'll make sure you can use your driveway.
